- 4. Draws will commence January 2, 2024 and will continue on the first Tuesday of every month in 2024 at Slave Lake Gymnastics, 629 Main St NE, Slave Lake.**
- 5. Prizes cannot be redeemed for cash.**
- 6. If the winner of one of the prizes cannot be located to claim said prize, the amount of the prize will be forfeited to Slave Lake Gymnastics after a timeframe of one year from the draw date and upon AGLC approval.**
- 7. Raffle tickets once purchased are non-refundable.**
